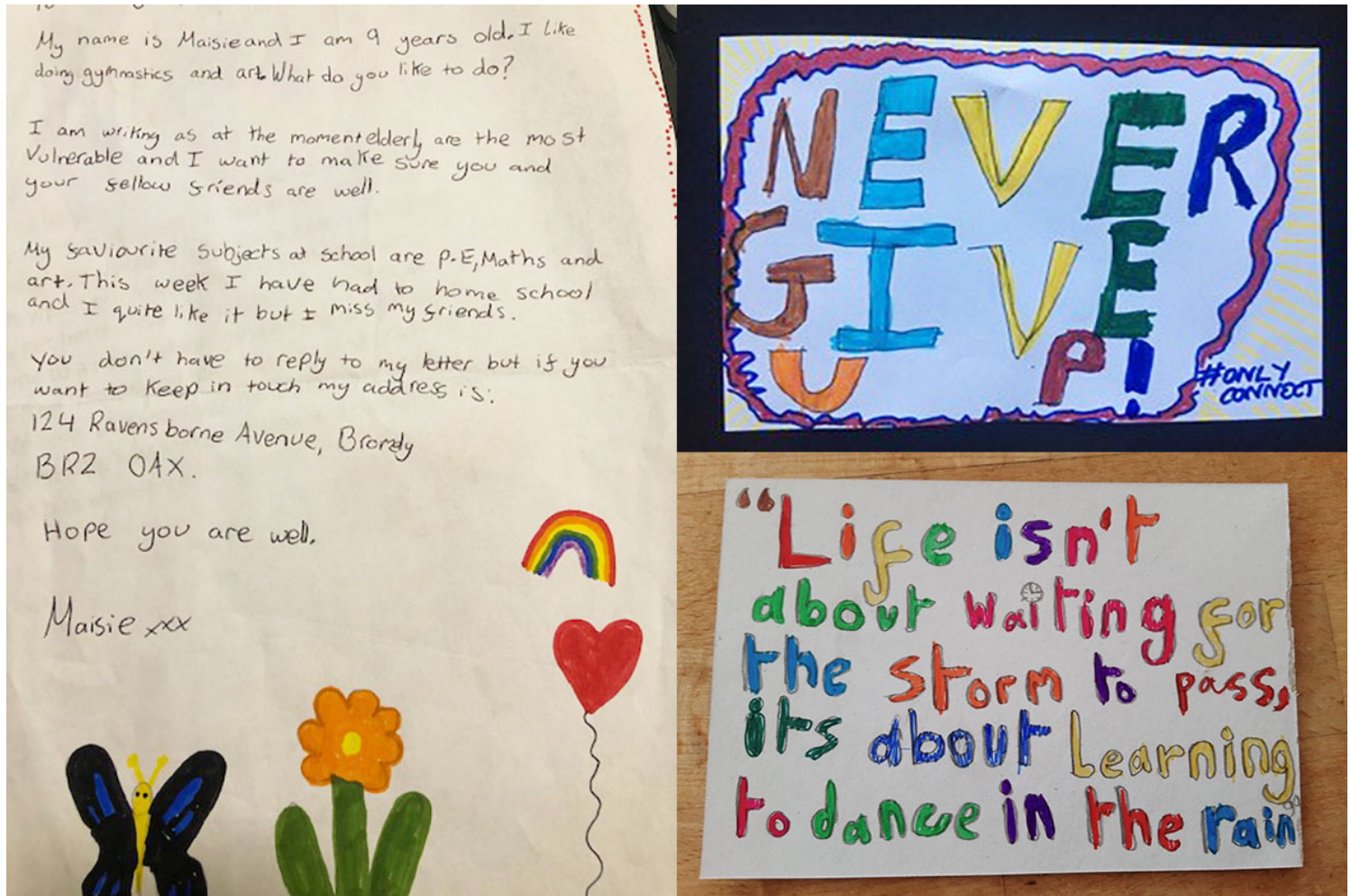


Children send heartwarming letters to Bromley Park Care Home
